#### **NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH**



On the night of 1st January someone broke into a car in Rodney Gardens. The glove compartment was emptied onto the floor and front seat. A small bag of loose change was taken. A resident, who sleeps in the front of their house, was awake and looked out when the security light was triggered and saw a person dressed in black outside.

On the night of 11tth January a car in St Lawrence Drive was broken into. The Passenger window was smashed and the satnay was stolen.

Around 4.00am on the 12th January someone was caught on CCTV shining a torch into car windows. He was clearly looking to see if there was anything there that was worth smashing the window to get to.

Around 4:30am on 4th February a resident in St. Lawrence Drive observed a man trying to open cars on driveways in Pamela Gardens and St. Lawrence Drive. When shouted at he walked off.

On 5th/6th February a van was ransacked around the area of 2 St Lawrence Drive. There was nothing of great value in the van. However in amongst paperwork was a set of car keys which were found approx 20 yards from the van thrown into the road.

Car break in incidents are becoming regular occurrences which our actions can help to void by not making ourselves soft targets.

If you can get your car off the road and onto your drive that would be safer. There are a few people on the estate with CCTV which, although doesn't appear to be a deterrent, does record events so the police can have something to go on if they choose to follow up.

Criminals are less likely to visit our estate if they never find an easy target. Never leave anything on view in the car, not even a bag of rubbish as this could be viewed as something worth taking when viewed from outside the car

Always check your car before going to bed to ensure that the doors are locked and valuables are removed.

#### **PAVEMENTS**

We believe the Council will be replacing other pavements on the estate at one road per financial year so it is incumbent on all of us to try and look after them.

#### 65+ Group

By the time this newsletter is circulated we will have had 6 of our, one a month, meetings and had a theatre trip. Meetings have been well attended with approximately 20 attendees each time. A total of 42 people have expressed interest in the group with 6 very recent additions. Not everyone can attend every meeting but attendances should increase with the recent additions. We have a variety of activities in the future including a quiz, a beetle drive, board games, guest speakers and, later in the year, an Armistice commemoration.

The Group is for EPEA members who have reached 65 years of age. The age limit was set partly to meet the criteria for council funding but also so we could focus on the mature age group.
